Taking an English language course in **South Africa** gives you the opportunity to discover a wide variety of natural phenomena like the world-class Kruger National Park which is regarded as one of the biggest conservation areas in the world, and hundreds of hectares of world renowned wine farms, or the scenic Garden Route from Cape Town to Port Elizabeth and much, much more. **Cape Town** also has one of the most bio-diverse floral kingdoms in the world for its size, and an unbelievable display of wild animals, from enormous sea creatures in the southern-right whale and the great-white shark to land mammals of the famous big five: lions, leopard, buffalo, elephants and rhino and finally over 900 species of bird life.

But that's not all! The city of Cape Town also offers outstanding value and opportunities for wine tasting in idyllic surroundings, visiting fine restaurants and shopping malls or a vibrant and eclectic night life and many other attractions, which are well enjoyed by all visitors. Cape Town is located at the south-western most tip of the African continent, where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Indian Ocean. The climate is warm and Mediterranean, with mild winters, and hot summers. The city offers a unique mix of African and European cultures to explore, wonderful natural surroundings and a world class cosmopolitan atmosphere. **You can practise and improve your English** by getting to know about South African culture by mingling with the locals

and finding out about the history of this part of the world - from its early peoples to the first European settlers. Learn about its modern day history and find out about the struggle for freedom and the birth of a rainbow nation through visiting sites like the Slave Lodge Museum where the early slaves to the Cape were housed, District Six Museum which is dedicated to the story of the forced removal of 60 000 people in the 1970s by the apartheid regime and finally the legendary **Robben Island** where **Nelson Mandela** was imprisoned on for many years. See the nation thrive on diversity, which manifested itself through great achievements as in a successfully organised 2010 FIFA World Cup.

English in Africa language school (EIA) is located in **Hout Bay**, a pleasant suburb of Cape Town, just 20 minutes drive from the city centre. As you will see it has its own character of independence and that's why people often refer to it as the *Republic of Hout Bay*. It has always been a favourite spot for both locals and tourists as it offers a relaxed seaside village atmosphere and two of the main attractions of the area – Chapman's Peak Drive and Hout Bay Harbour which includes Mariner's Wharf and Boat trips to see the Cape Fur seals at Duiker Island. Entry level English learners are equally welcome at the school as much as medium to advanced level English speakers

We do **four to seven lessons** a day from Monday to Friday, however the duration can be individually chosen. The school is flexible in its ability to adjust the length, intensity and focus of your particular studies. Lessons are 50 minutes each and then there's a 10 minute break. At **EIA** language school we don't believe that there is only one method to learn a language, therefore we offer English courses designed to satisfy your **specific needs**. There may be a particular focus on a specific area that the student is interested in or where he or she needs improvement. The student will be assessed and ranked accordingly on their very first day of school to recommend the **appropriate course level** for them to achieve the best possible outcome in their English language studies. 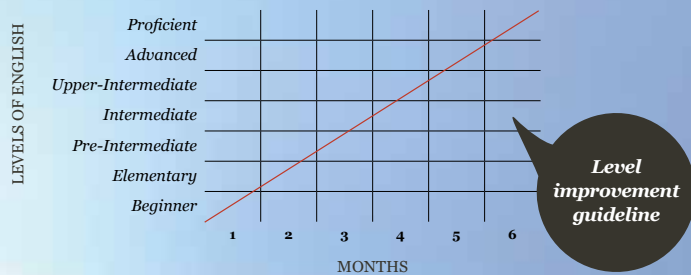

This programme is specially designed for university students or graduates, who would like to use the work experience to advance towards their future career. Our school can also facilitate **internship** placements or volunteer work programmes in cooperation with our associate local **voluntourism** agencies. This programme would enhance your CV and improve your chances in the job market greatly.

EIA also offers courses aimed at preparing students for either the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam or the **Cambridge** (University affiliated) **English certification exams**. Such certificates are internationally recognised for tertiary institution level studies in English and are the equivalent of state or national examinations in many countries. The school will prepare the student for the exam as well as book an exam date on behalf of the student. The exams take place in Cape Town throughout the year, but are taken on specific dates so booking well in advance of these dates is essential so that the student may cover the required work adequately in time to pass. Our school also offers the possibility to take **follow up courses over Skype**, where the student can take virtual classes with their teacher(s), so that they can hone their language skills further after they have finished their course with us.

We also offer our **ex-students special "Recharge your Batteries"** follow up courses at half the price of the initial course, where students who have studied with us in the past are invited to come back to Cape Town again for a brush up course to hone their language skills and to further improve their fluency.

EIA has a select team with international experience. All our English facilitators are either **TEFL** (Teaching of English as a Foreign Language) or **CELTA** (Certificate in English Language Teaching to Adults) certified and have several years of experience in teaching English to foreigners, either in South Africa or abroad. Our tutors are passionate and are thorough in their approach to teaching yet demanding in a friendly and relaxed manner. Every student we believe can make the most of their time at the best value from us.

THE SCHOOL IS HOUSED IN A HUNDRED YEAR OLD BUILDING on 2 acres of unspoiled land in the heart of Hout Bay. Renovated in an African fusion style, it offers modern facilities, including free tea, snacks and coffee. We offer free **WiFi internet**, so you are welcome to bring your own laptop or use the school computers in the common areas. Classrooms have all been renovated to preserve the traditional design of the buildings and are very spacious,

Accommodation

We offer a **Home-Stay** program, our recommended option which entails staying with a South African family so as to continue improving your English even after your lessons. Our **host families** provide rooms, optional breakfast and dinners based on the students' preferences. **EIA** also offers a stay in the **Student's Residence**, which brings you into contact with the other students from our school. The residence is conveniently located close to the school. It is a good accommodation option for sociable people who enjoy socialising and are keen to meet and interact with people from different cultures or countries outside the classroom. 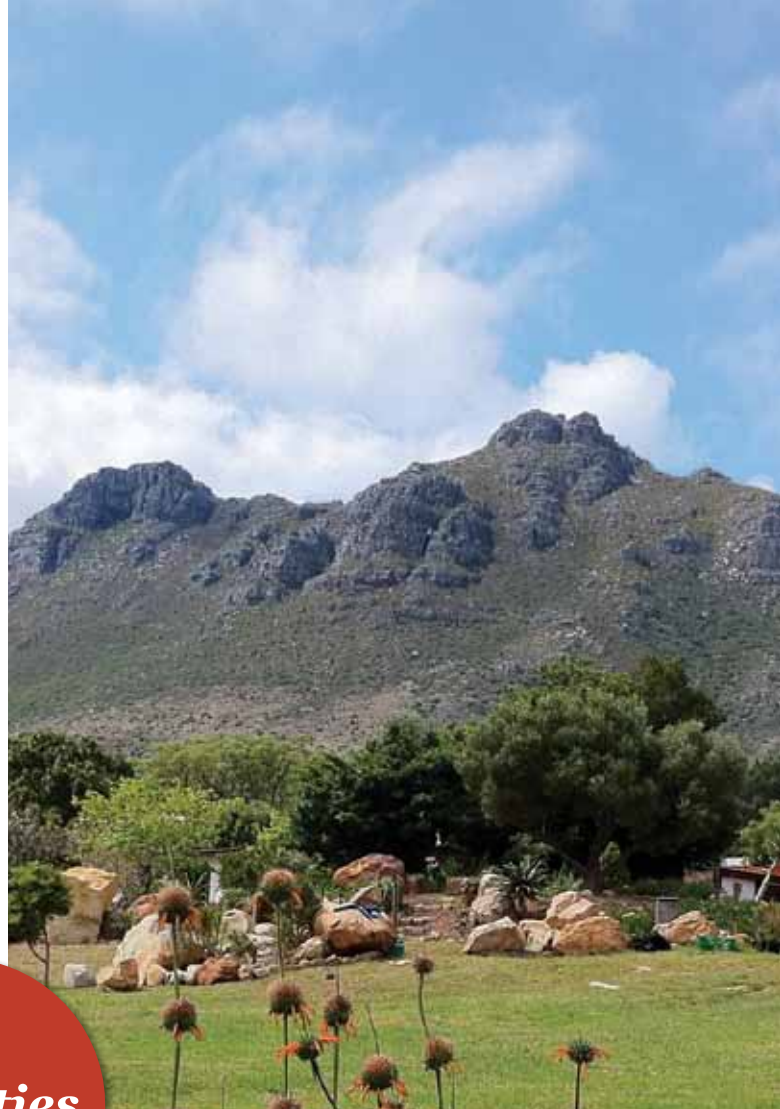
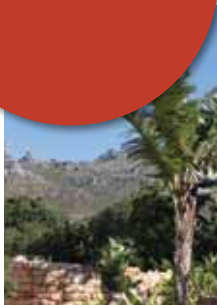


Sightseeing & Social Activities

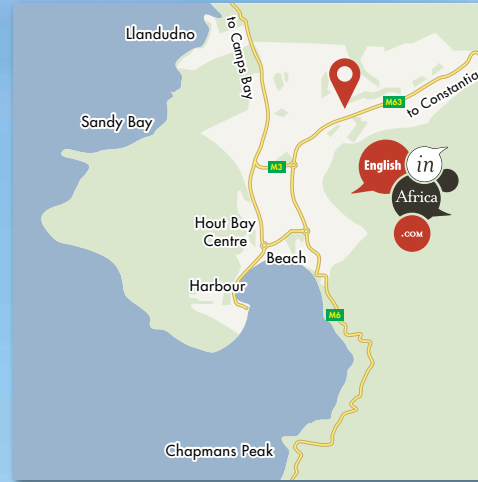
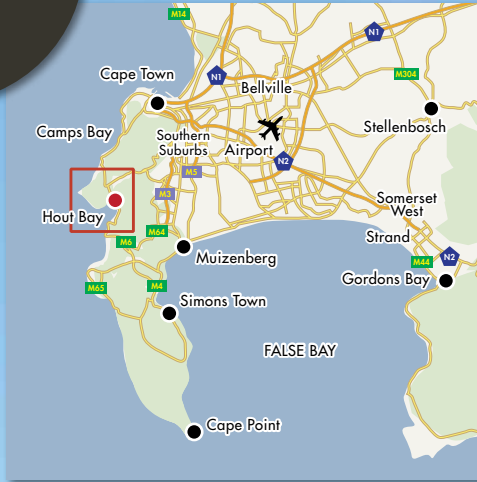
Hout Bay, Cape Town and the rest of the Cape Peninsula, offers a host of attractions and plenty of things to see and do. A city tour takes you to famous spots such as the colourful Bo-Kaap (old Malay Quarter), the Castle of Good Hope (one of the oldest buildings in the city), the Company Gardens (laid out by Jan van Riebeeck, founder of Cape Town) - a beautiful inner city park, District 6 Museum, (steeped in political history) and many more museums and art galleries. Table Mountain (and its famous cloud table cloth) is probably the most recognised landmark of Cape Town. Take a Cableway ride to the top for spectacular views over the city, Lions Head and Devil's Peak, complementing the famous Cape Town skyline. Signal Hill, at the foot of Lions Head, is the site of the Noon Gun fired daily at 12pm.

You can also take a trip out of the city and visit the winelands, where you can taste some of the world's finest wines or venture to Cape Point to see the unspoiled wilderness. The more adventurous can try cage diving with Great White sharks or taking a helicopter flight to enjoy birds-eye vistas of the city and the peninsula. The school will organise the various activities for you - have you ever considered doing a safari adventure or horse riding on the beach?
